D'PERU TEXTIL: INTERNATIONAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

EXPORT AGREEMENT:

- Our textiles are prices FOB Peru
- We will start production as soon as the Proforma is approved and payment is received according to the agreed terms. Once your advance payment is confirmed, we will provide you with an updated delivery schedule
- Post-approval modifications to designs are subject to price revisions. D'PERU TEXTIL reserves the right to adjust the final quote according to the level of complexity and additional work involved in these changes.

PRICES:

- Prices are quoted in USD and are typically valid for three months. However, we reserve the right to adjust pricing in the event of significant fluctuations in exchange rates or raw material costs. In such cases, D'PERU TEXTIL will notify customers before any changes take effect.
- Prices include standard labeling and packing.

EXPORT MARKETS:

- USA, Canada, Mexico, Japan, China, Finland, Thailand, Denmark, France, Italy, Germany, Netherlands, Norway, Sweden and Chile.

SHIPMENTS:

- Air, Sea or Courier Cargo. We also consolidate shipments with other Peruvian vendors.

D'PERU TEXTIL: INTERNATIONAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

MINIMUM ORDERS (MOQ):

Garments : 100 Units per Style , 2 colours

60 Units pers Style, 2 Colours if the style is One Size

Home & Accessories: 40 Pieces per style, 2 colours

**In all cases if the yarn is available in our stock or form part of the supplier's stock, if not, minimum quantities depends on minimun yarn order from our yarn suppliers, that is, the total consumption of yarn.

** Orders below our minimums may have extra charges because of export costs.

PRODUCTION LEAD TIME:

It depends of the quantity in the order and our production schedule - workshop capacity at time of order placement. Our normal shipping time is between 10 -18 weeks (8 weeks -if the yarn is available on stock) after proforma has been approved and the advance payment has been received.

PAYMENT TERMS:

50% in advance and 50% against documents, before the sipments. We only accept bank transferences, no credit cards payments.

D'PERU TEXTIL: INTERNATIONAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

SAMPLES DEVELOPMENT:

- We need the information of the pieces to develop: Measured sheets, which yarn you want to use, if you are still not clear about this information, we can guide you according to a reference image or physical sample that you have to give us.
- Sample development can cost FOB price x2.5 , or more, according to difficulty.
- Samples need to be paid fully before shipment and are usually shipped collect using our customer's courier account. Otherwise, freight should be paid in advance.
- Product development Lead Time: 2 or 3 weeks, depends if the yarn is available on stock and the styles information are complete.
- Handloom weave samples, in this line minimum is 12 units.

LABELLING AND PACKING:

Standard labelling and packing includes:

- Composition-care label in white satin and black letters.
- Packed in a clear plastic bag with vent holes.
- Double Corrugated Master box as a final pack with a maximum weight of 20 Kg.
- General Packing Labels are placed in the master box.

** Special packing costs as for hang tags, labels (brand, size, others), barcodes and stickers, may be added and shown on the Proforma Invoice. Special tagging can also be provided by customer. Special labelling and packing may be charged to customer according to its cost.

SAMPLING FROM OUR CATALOGUE: - Samples can be provided upon request, and they may have FOB price x 2. - Samples need to be paid fully in advance and are usually shipped collect using our customer's courier account. Otherwise, freight should be paid in advance.

EXCLUSIVITY:

At D'PERU TEXTIL, we strictly honor the intellectual property of our clients' designs. Additionally, exclusivity for designs from our own proprietary catalog can be granted under specific commercial terms and conditions.

ABANDONED MERCHANDISE:

If a customer does not honor agreed payment when being noticed of readiness of merchandise, or does not send notice about how to proceed with this merchandise, D'PERU TEXTIL will declare it abandoned after 2 months of the agreed shipping date of not hearing from customer. If this happens, D'PERU TEXTIL will take necessary actions in order to recover its investment and inform customer of this. If customer has made advancement, D'PERU TEXTIL may deduct from here all costs involved in the operation before returning advancement.
